1. **Meeting called to order** at 7:04 p.m.
2. **Welcome & Introductions**
3. **Fred Baruzzi, Superintendent of Schools:**
 - There was a town council meeting last Thursday. There will be no referendum on the November 6 ballot. There is a new proposal to build two new schools at the same locations (Vinton & Goodwin) one at a time, instead of at the same time. They believe the cost to tax payers would be more level. They are going to do more research and will come back to the committee by December 31st. There may be a referendum in the spring.
 - In the middle of October, parents, students and teachers will have the opportunity to participate in an online survey regarding school climate. Information will be sent out in mid-September.
 - The PTO (that's you!) is invited to attend any BOE meeting.
4. **Curt Vicente, Director of Parks & Rec:**
 - Jean Bell retired and Mansfield parks & rec have taken over the after school program.
 - Duncan Campbell is the new head teacher at Southeast. All questions should be directed to him.
 - Bill Callahan is the full time staff person who will oversee the program.
 - Rates increased in May, but did not change this fall.
 - Drop-in service is still available.
 - There is no registration fee this year, but drop-in people are asked to pre-pay.
 - People who qualify can receive a reduced rate.
5. **Two schools building project:**
 - Suggestion: we could use a "community closet" (storage) for the PTO and afterschool programs.
 - Southeast parents are encouraged to write statements & go to town council meetings expressing any concerns about the 2 schools project.
 - We will discuss this topic in depth at the next PTO meeting (October 1st). The meeting will

start early, at 6:30. Likely, we will have a BOE member and a town council member present. It was suggested that we contact Bill Ryan, a former southeast parent.

-Erin Clark, Sylvia Dorado, Jana MacDonald, Jess Higham, Cyndi Wells & Lena Rossi will meet to put together information for the meeting (concerns, etc). They will also do their best to get the word out about the meeting.

6. Review of ongoing PTO programs:

-Big Y Educatio: Register at the check-out and the school can receive certain items from Big Y (in the past we've gotten balls for PE, etc).

-Stop n Shop: Go online or call to register. Buy participating items and our school can earn cash.

-Box tops: Collect them from soup labels, cereal boxes, toilet paper, etc. Cut them out and bring them in to the school to earn cash for the school.

-Campbell's soup labels: Cut them out and bring them into school. Last year we bought a bench for the playground with the money earned.

7. PTO fundraisers and events:

-Gardening Program: Jean Johnson will be the PTO liason to the Garden Club. She will work with Lisa Cackowski on this.

-Jeannine fundraiser (wrapping paper, chocolate, cookie dough) coming out soon.

-We will try to include what percentage of the sales goes to Southeast.

- fundraising suggestion: Mabel's Labels (kids labels, we would earn 25%)

-fall bulbs: We would like to do this differently this year. We plan to buy bulbs in bulk, separate them and sell them individually. Any leftover will be planted at the school.

-We are not certain whether or not we will have a parent's hour each month (before the PTO meetings). Last year they were not well attended.

8. School pictures:

-Mansfield Middle School also uses them. If you have kids at both schools, you can get a multiple child discount.

-They also do sibling pictures for your kids at Southeast.

-Retakes will be inside in November if you want a different background

9. Fall Carnival & silent auction:

-Erin Christopher has found volunteers from UCONN and EO Smith, but we still need more volunteers for both the fall carnival and silent auction.

- Jack Rabbit's will provide the food.
- Gwen suggested that parents can donate individual snacks to be sold (individual pretzels, granola bars, etc)
- Erin is trying to get a fire truck and may include an ispy activity.
- Other activities may include face painting, scavenger hunt & nature walk, bounce house, henna tattoo, games
- Jess needs help putting together baskets (Jess will send out dates)
- Jess still needs help soliciting businesses. Contact her if you would like to help.

10. **Southeast Network:**
