Field Trip:

The Field Trip started at 1:30 and ended at 2:20 p.m. It was a "windshield survey" conducted by car, to observe the potential for new sidewalks, starting at Eastwood, Westwood, Hillside Circle and Bolton Roads, with the idea of completing the sidewalk circuit already in place there. We then observed the potential for a sidewalk on the west side of Route 195, going north from UConn's Greek Village all the way to Four Corners, and continuing from there along 195 to Holiday Mall. We also observed uncompleted segments of Hunting Lodge Road, from Birch Road Roundabout to Goodwin School and also from North Eagleville Road going south to Separatist Road. We viewed again the upper path between Glen Ridge Cooperative and Juniper Hill Village. We ended our trip by observing where a sidewalk was needed on a small segment of South Eagleville Road: on the north side of South Eagleville Road from the Town Hall property eastward to the junction with 195.

The meeting was adjourned at the conclusion of the Field Trip at 2:20 p.m.
