2022-2023 Superintendent's Proposed Budget Review: Mrs. Lyman initiated the review and indicated there are a number of changes due to the consolidation of the elementary schools. The review began with a presentation of staffing changes including those as a result of school consolidation, enrollment decline, and supporting needs brought on by the pandemic. Mrs. Morell and Ms. Rodriguez presented the general instructional program budgets for each account for grades 5-8 and K-4 respectively.

Mrs. Lyman indicated which sections of the budget will be reviewed at the February 3rd workshop and encouraged questions in advance.
