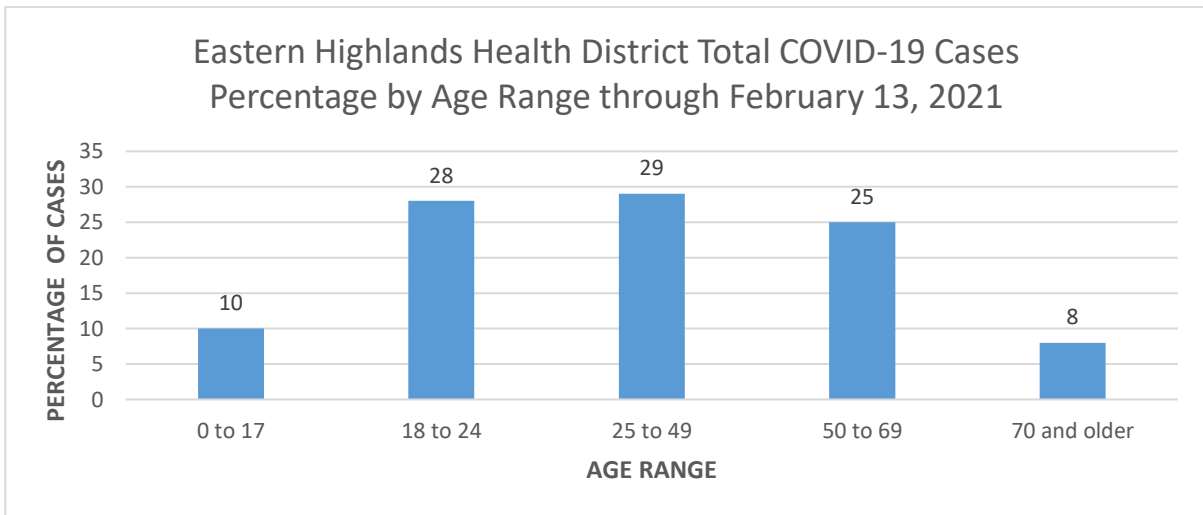
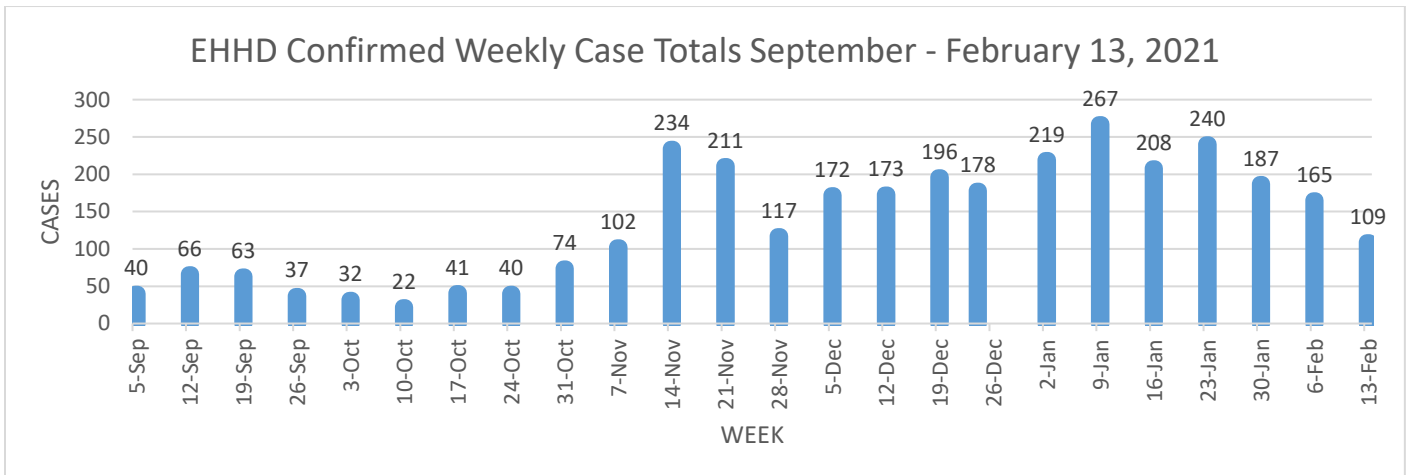
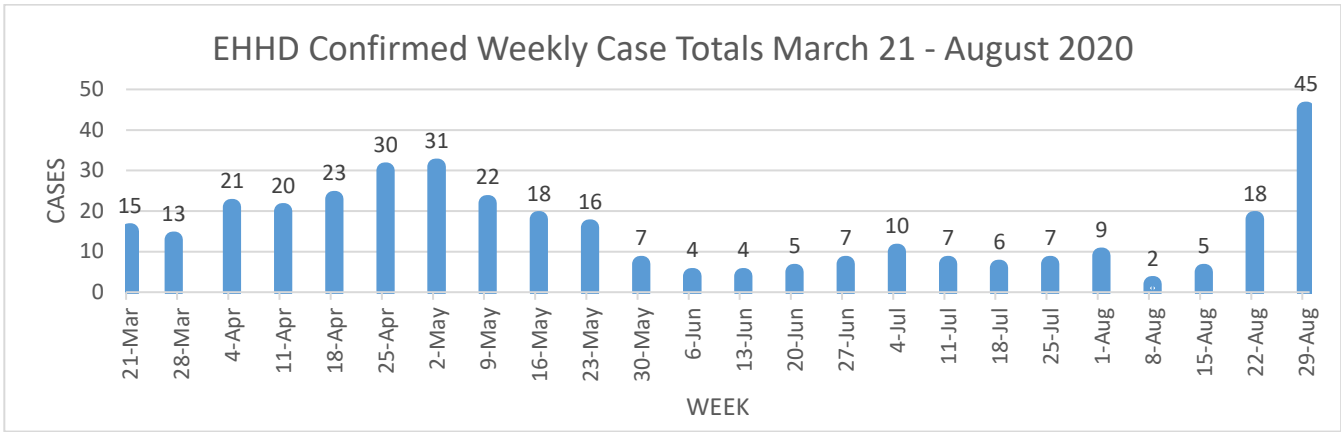

Recent EHHD News:

- The EHHD conducted 4 vaccination clinics for phase 1a eligible personnel and those 65+ in the past week. 420 doses were administered. 5 additional clinics are scheduled for coming week for 2nd dose recipients and those 65 and over.

- **Based on health district contact tracing evidence, disease transmission within our population is largely driven by small gatherings of family members not from the same household, small social gatherings, and workplace settings.**
