The meeting was called to order at 4:46pm by Ms. Ward.

Motion by Ms. Everett, seconded by Ms. Zimmermann to enter Executive Session at 4:53pm for the purpose of a discussion concerning non-union wages and salaries, a discussion concerning collective bargaining matters related to the teacher contract and invite Superintendent Lyman and Peter Dart.

Following Executive Session, the Board returned to Regular Session at 5:19pm. Motion by Ms. Everett, seconded by Ms. Picard to accept the Personnel Committee's recommendation of singleton salaries for 2022-23. All singletons (Information Technology staff, food service director, human resource specialist, administrative assistant to the superintendent, and Deputy Director of Facilities) receive a 3% increase. Insurance cost sharing remains at 13%. Vote: Unanimous in favor.

Motion by Ms. Everett, seconded by Ms. Zimmermann that the MBOE amend the 2021-22 school year to allow the last day of school for students as June 20<sup>th</sup>. Vote: Unanimous in favor.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion by Ms. Morin, seconded by Ms. Everett to adjourn at 5:21pm. Vote: Unanimous in favor.
