  - Summer learning or enrichment, extended day, comprehensive after school, or extended school year programs
- Ensure interventions include responding to academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, especially those disproportionally impacted by the pandemic
- Describe how funds will be used to implement prevention and mitigation strategies
- Engage in meaningful consultation with stakeholders when creating plan and describe in application
